Match Awards and Prize Policies

Recognition Awards (plaques) will be awarded by division and class, with one award for the top performer in each division per class, and one additional award for every 5 competitors. Not to exceed 5 places per Category or Class.

1. Divisions

A minimum of 10 competitors per Division

2. Categories

Division status must be achieved before Categories are recognized.

A minimum of 5 competitors per Division

Category (see approved list below)

3. Individual Categories:

Categories approved for individual recognition are as follows:

- a. Lady
- b. Junior Competitors under the age of 18 on the first day of the match.
- c. Senior Competitors over the age of 55 on the first day of the match
- d. Super Senior Competitors over the age of 65 on the first day of the match. A competitor over the age of 65 on the first day of the match may enter Senior Category only if Super Senior is unavailable.
- e. Military personnel on current active duty orders.
- f. Law Full-time law enforcement officers with arrest powers.

4. Individual Classes:

Division status must be achieved before Classes are recognized.

A minimum of 10 competitors per Class (mandatory)

Merchandise prizes will be awarded top to bottom, by performance, using the actual division percentages in a combined set of results. Shooters who placed 100% in their respective divisions will go first. The remaining shooters will visit the prize table in descending order of their actual match percentages. ([See Sample list](#))

This is a strict performance based distribution of prizes. In the case of gift certificates, the prize is the certificate (i.e., redemption issues are between the competitor and the sponsor).

Winners must meet all Federal, State and local requirements. Winners of Firearms or Serial numbered firearm components must provide a signed copy of a valid FFL (Federal Firearms License) of the dealer in the winner's State of residence in order to transfer the firearm.
