The Keystone State's David Olhasso Wins Regional Shooting Championship

Sedro-Woolley, WA — David Olhasso of Holland, Pennsylvania won the Limited-10 Division title at the TechWear USA Area 8 Practical Shooting Championships held over the Memorial Day weekend at the East Huntingdon Sportsmen's Association range in Alverton, Pennsylvania.

Olhasso captured the Limited-10 title by winning six of the 11 stages and led the match from start to finish. James Smith finished behind Olhasso with Howard Thompson in third and Matt Griffin and John Hill rounding out the top five.

“David shot a strong match from the start. He took an early lead winning the first four stages giving himself a margin that the rest of the field simply could not overcome,” said Alan Meek, USPSA's Area 8 Director.

The USPSA Area 8 Championships were held May 22-25 with a total of 312 top shooters competed in USPSA's Open, Limited, Limited-10, Production, Revolver and Single Stack divisions. The USPSA Area 8 region includes Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Virginia but shooters from across the Nation and around the world are invited to compete.
