

2007 USPSA Junior Camp Scholarship

The 2007 USPSA Junior Camp (Camp Shootout) will be held from June 27 to 30, 2007 at "The Shootout" near Shreveport, Louisiana. USPSA funds the camp tuition for one junior from each of USPSA's eight Areas. Although any other interested juniors are invited to attend, they must pay the tuition fee for this week long camp (room and board included).

Interested Area 8 resident Juniors must apply no later than April 22. A Selection Committee, with one representative from each Section within Area 8, will review all applications and (if necessary) interview the applicants. The chosen recipient will be announced on May 15. The winner will be required to write an article on his/her experience within 30 days of completion. Photographs are also welcome. The article may be selected for publication in Front Sight.

Send a letter describing yourself and outlining your interests, school activities, and shooting experience. No specific format is required, however, your letter will be your primary application presentation. Feel free to add anything to support your application. Include your membership number, the names and home address of your parents, your home telephone number and e-mail address.
